2026 Legislative Agenda

1. Consider amending Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) § 38-783 to define “an employer's active employee group health and accident insurance program” to clarify that a retiree who is receiving subsidized health insurance either as an employee or as the dependent of an employee of an employer is not eligible for the ASRS premium benefit subsidy.
2. Consider amending A.R.S. § 38-727 to clarify that an employee of an employer who initially becomes eligible to participate in the ASRS after age 65 may elect to waive participation in the ASRS within 30 days after becoming eligible to participate in the ASRS.
3. Consider amending A.R.S. § 38-797.07(A)(11)(b) to clarify that after receiving benefits for a total of 24 months, a member is considered to have a disability if the member is unable to perform any work for which the member is reasonably qualified, based on objective medical evidence.
