The Technology Services Division of the ASRS is seeking an individual to manage the build process and release coordination. The **Build/Release Engineer** needs to be a highly motivated individual who can work in a fast-paced environment completing specific tasks in a timely manner without significant guidance.

Description of duties:

- Responsible for builds, deployment plans, and release activities.
- Administer the source code repository (**SVN/Mercurial**), continuous build implementation (**Bamboo**), code review tool (**Crucible**), source code UI (**Fisheye**), as well as our static code analysis tools (**Nexus and Sonar**).
- Create and execute build plans and deploy artifacts for specified products in various environments.
- Advocate new tools and processes to continuously improve build and source control efficiency.
- Troubleshoot problems related to builds, deployment of artifacts, or environment configuration.
- Manage Windows/Linux servers to maintain and deploy the builds for various environments.
