The Arizona State Retirement System is seeking an auditor to perform field audits of the operations of the state pension plan's divisions and related programs.

THE AUDITOR will work independently with minimal supervision and prepare work papers that document findings; will be responsible for planning, testing and evaluating the divisions and systems audited and prepare a report to both the Director of the agency and the Board of Trustees. The audits range from average to considerable complexity and require a thorough knowledge of the pension plan system and its procedures and state statutes.
