We want an experienced IT Security Engineer with server administrator skills and a dedicated security background. This critical support role will be responsible for supporting the review, research and implementation of the remediation measures indicated for endpoints (servers, workstations, printers, etc.) that are discovered from the vulnerability reporting tools. The successful candidate must have the knowledge, skills, and abilities and to:

- Collaborate and effectively communicate with business and technical staff to assist them in protecting the agency information assets
- Have the ability to completely document a task, particularly where it requires the diligence to train staff and protect the agency assets
- Set and work within deadlines to complete assignments, exercise resourcefulness and prioritize tasks to meet multiple demands
- Follow set objectives and goals to measure performance
- Effectively work independently and interact with others in a team environment
- Assist in the delivery of projects on-time and within budgetary constraints
- Be detail oriented and thorough
- Be able to develop and follow procedures, analyze problems and assist in the designing of effective plans for process improvement
- Ability to identify security issues and risks, and develop mitigation plans
